By 2011, AAIM had implemented programs in 25 countries of the sub-Saharan Africa.

- ***Caring for the Vulnerable Children***
Orphans Care, Feeding Programs, Clothing and Shoes Distribution
- ***Caring for the Youth***
Special Programs for the Youth - Resilience & Prevention of Risky Behaviors
- ***Caring for the Care Givers***
HIV/AIDS Education and Support for the Grandmothers & Grandmothers' Clubs.
