AAIM is a special ministry of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, that assists to mobilize the Adventist network of churches and institutions in the response to the HIV epidemic. AAIM started in 2004.

By 2011, AAIM had implemented programs in 25 countries of the sub-Saharan Africa.
